PROGRAM OVERVIEW We have four 1st, four 2nd, & four 3rd year positions. One 3rd year will spend the 3rd year in San Diego, splitting time between Scripps Mercy San Diego, Kaiser San Diego, Scripps Green & Sharp Rees Stealy. Two residents will spend their 3rd year at the Kaiser Program in Sacramento (30 podiatrists). One resident will spend their 3rd year at Kaiser Fontana/Ontario (9 podiatrists in Riverside County Calif). We have rotations at Kaiser San Diego (13 podiatrists), Sharp Rees Stealy (8 podiatrists) & Scripps Clinic/Scripps Green Hospital (5 podiatrists), Navy (2 podiatrists) besides Scripps Mercy during the 2nd year. There is a strong emphasis on biomechanics as well as surgery and trauma. There are excellent outside rotations as well. The first 2 years are the same. A separate selection category is set up for the three different 3rd year spots (San Diego, Sacramento, Fontana)
