Office and billing experience is handled through the clinic as well as podiatric private practices. Hospital-based clinic experience is done while working closely with the other medicine residents. Rotations are designed to expose the resident to all of the necessary skills needed to function and be successful in private practice or group practice.

Residents are required by graduation to submit a paper for publication by the end of the 3rd year to graduate and all 3rd year residents are required to attend the ACFAS Annual Scientific Conference.
