PROGRAM OVERVIEW Our institution offers a well-rounded reconstructive, podiatric medical/surgical program. The residents cover the Wound Center and the Lower Extremity Fellow Clinic weekly, which offers continuity of patient care from the ER, to inpatient and also outpatient.
