## PROGRAM OVERVIEW This is a PMSR/RRA program.

This is a diverse program with surgical and clinical numbers approximately 1 1/2 - 2 times the CPME requirements. There is a wide variety of foot and ankle pathology, including diabetic limb salvage, elective reconstruction and trauma. The residents are fully intergrated with allopathic residents. All post-operative University Hospital patients are followed in the podiatry clinic.
